

**A Memorandum of Understanding**

**Between**

**The University of Chile**

**And**

**The University of Jordan**

This MoU is made and entered by and between the University of Chile, represented by its Rector, Professor Dr. Luis A. Riveros with legal address at Bernardo O'Higgins 1058 Santiago, Chile, and the University of Jordan, represented by its president, Professor Abdelrahim A. Hunaiti with legal address at Queen Rania Street ,Amman, Jordan.

WTTNESSETH:

Whereas it would be mutually beneficial to establish a program of academic cooperation between the two parties, in order to contribute to the development of their common objectives.

Whereas the parties wish to state in writing their interest to work in joint programs and the terms under which they will accomplish mutual work.

Whereas said statements and interests of both parties are to be described in the following articles:

NOW THEREFORE, it is mutually agreed by the two parties hereto as follows:

Article 1. *Objective*

The parties will identify the areas of common interest and will elaborate the projects that they wish to develop jointly.

Article 2. *Activities*

The activities foreseen in the previous article include, among others:

- a. Faculty exchange.
- b. Student exchange.
- c. Exchange of publications.
- d. Development of joint research projects.
- e. Co-supervision of thesis and dissertations.
- f. Joint publications.

Article 3. *Working Procedures*

Each subject area, project or activity identified as being of common interest will be described in Specific MoUs and /or Addendum to this MoU which will include the terms and conditions of exchange ,the parties' responsibilities, and the academics, scientific, administrative, and financial details for its implementation.

The parties entrust their corresponding Directors of International Relations with the less of coordinating the preparation and implementation of proposals. Both will propose ways to select and evaluate projects . Furthermore, they shall promote, within their own institutions an adequate and successful student and faculty participation in programs implemented under the terms of this MoU.

Article 4. *Funding*

Each project or activity agreed in specific MoUs and/or Addendum to this MoU will be attended to individually, according to the resources available. The resources needed to implement such projects or activities will be negotiated with suitable funding agencies by the project coordinators. Supported by both universities likewise and depending on resources available, the parties will develop activities funded with their own financial resources.

Article 5. *Validity*

This MoU is valid for a period of five(5) years, and will be renewed for additional 5-year period, unless one of the contracting parties notifies the other, in writing, its intent to terminate at least three (3) months before termination date.




This MoU will become effective on the date official representatives of both universities sign the MoU.
