

Memorandum of Understanding

between

The University of Jordan

and

The University of Auckland

First Party: The University of Jordan, Amman, 11942, Jordan.

Second Party: The University of Auckland, Private Bag 92019, Auckland, New Zealand.

The two parties hereby agree to work collaboratively on the placement of PhD candidates in relevant research programmes.

Each year the first party may nominate PhD candidates to enrol at the second party. The second party shall make the final admission decisions in each case.


Any amendment of this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) must be by written agreement between the two institutions. No such amendment or revision will come into effect until both institutions have agreed in writing to this amendment or revision

This MoU shall be effective upon approval by both parties and shall remain in effect for a period of three years. Thereafter, subject to a review by each institution which confirms the MoU is achieving the objectives set out above, it shall be automatically renewed from year to year. However, after the initial period either institution may terminate the MoU at the end of a given academic year by giving six months notice in writing of such intent, provided that termination by one party shall not affect any activities already approved under this MoU.


